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Drinking Window: 2020 - 2025

For her masterful Finger Lakes Chardonnay, Nova Cadamatre used fruit from the Nutt Road Vineyard on the northwest side of Seneca Lake. The fruit is gently destemmed prior to pressing and fermentation in a combination of stainless-steel and oak casks. The result is impressively ripe but not over the top, with notes of apple and passion fruit just barely touched with honey. The wine is aged a year in cask on the lees, bringing a suggestion of spice and cream. Lovely!

Made in a mix of new and used oak, plus some stainless steel. Limited production. Drink or hold.
