Drinking Window: 2020 - 2025

This 2016 Riesling was made with fruit from the Zugibe Vineyard on the northeast side of Seneca Lake. The fruit was destemmed and pressed with a couple hours of skin contact to add complexity. The aroma features notes of ripe apricot and dried flowers with just a bit of petrol adding depth. The 4g/l of residual sugar balances out the very crisp acidity to achieve ethereal equilibrium and length.
