Drinking Window: 2020 - 2025

A wet, cool season in 2017 produced a wine of finesse and elegance but lacking perhaps the concentration of other recent vintages. The Zugibe Vineyard grapes produced pleasant lime and citrus aromas with suggestion of acacia flowers. On the palate a hint of sweetness balances out the very crisp acidity, leading to a whisper-soft finish whose restraint did not detract from its elegance.
