Drinking Window: 2020 - 2025

Conditions in 2018 produced some rot in the Finger Lakes. This meant strict sorting, but also a touch of noble rot that made for lush, delicious wines in the style of Austrian Smaragd. The Trestle 31 Riesling shows notes of ripe peach and honeysuckle with a suggestion of saffron. The aromas are exotic but the sweetness (at just over 8g/l residual sugar) is readily balanced by the acidity retained with the cool autumn harvest season.

An exceptional Finger Lakes riesling that's closer to a Wachau Smaragd than the region's established range of style for this grape. Very mouth-filling and succulent with great textural complexity, as well as a slew of mango and papaya, plus a hint of floral honey. Not bone-dry, but dry enough at the long, complex finish to drag you back for more. Drink or hold.
